A GOLF AND RECREATIONAL COMMUNITY

For some golfers, the natural beauty at StoneRidge, set among northern Idaho's thick conifer forests and blue mountain lakes, is enough reason to keep coming back. For others, it is the pure challenge of the par 7I championship golf course with just enough water hazards and white sand bunkers to make even the biggest hitters play with care. Completely redesigned in 2001 by Frank Burandt, formerly of Nicklaus Design Group, the course features 7.032 yards of Kentucky Blue Grass with Bent Grass greens. Situated at the base of Mount Spokane and bordering the beautiful Lake San Succi, it remains a true test for golfers of all skill levels.

The dialene

Home of the Floating Green, the Coeur d'Alene Resort Golf Course is nestled in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains on the shores of beautiful Lake Coeur d'Alene in northern Idaho. Ranked as the #2 resort golf course in the nation, second only to Pebble Beach, it features fairways that play from tee to green on a lush carpet of Bent Grass. Scott Miller designed the 6,803 yard, par 71 course around four distinct geographic features: an expansive lakeshore, a forested ridge, gently rolling woodlands and Fernan Creek, a revitalized trout stream. It is a course playable for families, yet challenging enough to test the pros. Summer Stay & Play Packages starting at only \$184 per person.

Circling Raven was created amid a unique blend of wetlands, grasslands and woodlands. At 7,189 yards, the par 72 championship layout meanders through 620 acres, with only 100 representing cultivated ground. Named "Top 100 Courses You Can Play" by Golf Magazine, "Best Resort Courses" by Golfweek Magazine and recently named to Golf Digest's -America's 100 Greatest Golf Courses- Public Access. On the back nine, the only hole visible is the hole you are playing. Wetlands impact play on 13 holes. Natural grasses balance the wetlands on 16 holes, and surround the closely manicured Blue Grass fairways and Bent Grass greens. Take the "Tees and Threes," challenge, four par 3s, each over 200 yards from the back tees.

University of Idaho Golf Course

Withstanding the test of time, the University of Idaho Golf Course was originally designed by Francis L. James and constructed in 1933. Nestled among the rolling hills of the Palouse, vistas of wheat change with the seasons from emerald green to amber gold against a mountain backdrop. This unique course is challenging, offering a variety of shots from uneven lies to elevated and recessed greens. The front nine provides scoring opportunities featuring three par 5s in an open grassland venue. The back nine tightens up into a narrow parkland theme, including two difficult par 3s. The round concludes by running the gauntlet of the last 3 challenging holes known by locals as "Heartbreak Ridge."

MEADOW CREEK

MeadowCreek public golf resort enjoys one of the grandest settings in America, with dazzling views in every direction. Conveniently located in the heartland of Idaho, 13 miles north of McCall, it is an easy drive from both southern and northern Idaho and makes the perfect stopover. The 6,696 yard, par 72 course is situated 3,868 feet above sea level in the beautiful Meadows Valley, with the peaks of Granite and Brundage Mountain Ski Area reaching skyward in the distance. The course weaves in and out of the pine trees and across the verdant meadows offering changing scenery and stimulating golf at every turn. Ranked by men's course rating, MeadowCreek is 7th in the state.

JUG MOUNTAIN RANCH

MCCALL, IDAHO

Jug Mountain Ranch is a world-class course that respectfully takes advantage of the spectacular setting nature provided. Enjoy wonderful alpine links while taking in gorgeous panoramic views of Jughandle Mountain, the Ranch's natural wetlands and old growth forests. The 7,265 yard, par 72 course was designed by Donald Knott, whose previous work included the widely acclaimed Links at Spanish Bay (Pebble Beach), Rancho La Quinta, Sun Valley Resort and more than 60 other courses worldwide. The course is proud to be ranked in 2007 as the second best new public course under \$75 by Golf Digest.

Whitetai

The Whitetail Golf Course is the very definition of a mountain masterpiece. Designed by twotime U.S. Open winner Andy North, the course is carved through dense forest, towering pines and sweeping meadows. Lush green fairways are meticulously cut in perfect checkerboard patterns and give way to large rolling greens. Trout ponds, white sand bunkers, large mountain boulders and occasional wildlife compose a variety of expected and sometimes unexpected obstacles. At more than 7,200 yards and with a new green #4, the par 72 will challenge and delight you.

The par 72 course utilizes multiple tees at each hole to provide a variety of lengths—from 7,319 for experienced players to 5,003 for more casual players.

Located just 10 minutes south of Interstate 84 in Kuna, Idaho, Falcon Crest offers 18 holes on its Championship Course or an executive 9-hole course designed to test all your best shots. It is a challenging 6,890 yard, par 71 layout. In 2005, BanBury was the host site for the U.S. Girls' Championship, and hosted the 2009 Idaho Open in September. Discover what Golf Digest calls one of the best golf resorts in North America. The Sun Valley Resort Golf Course comprises three different courses offering 45 holes of challenging golf for every level of player.

Trail Creek Course | PAR: 72 | YDS: 6,968

Sun Valley's signature course, Trail Creek, promises to provide a challenging round of golf for every level of player. Robert Trent Jones Jr. finished his re-design of this traditional alpine course in 1980 with a full complement of stream carries and ominous bunkers well positioned to catch the errant shot. The 6,968 yard, par 72 course has 18 signature holes and crosses the beautiful Trail Creek seven times on the front nine alone!

White Cloud Course | PAR: 36 | YDS: 3,605

When standing atop the White Clouds, your eye captures a 360-degree wrap-around view of the Wood River Valley encompassing Bald Mountain, Dollar Mountain, the Pioneer Mountains, Angel's Perch, Devil's Bedstead and the home of Ernest Hemingway. With their breathtaking views atop a stunning ridgeback, the White Cloud Course will promise to rival any course in the country.

Elkhorn Course | PAR: 72 | YDS: 7,214

The Elkhorn Golf Club was designed by Robert Trent Jones and re-designed in 2005 and is now under Sun Valley Resort ownership and management. Sun Valley Resort guests will enjoy this long, (7,214-yard) course with its mix of valley holes and those which traverse foothills as it beautifully compliments play on Sun Valley's Trail Creek Course and the White Clouds.

Pinecrest is an 18-hole public course with Bent Grass greens and tree-lined fairways. Designed by the legendary William H. Tucker, it was constructed in 1936. Surrounded by open skies and pine trees, the course was developed with small greens and slightly sloped hills. Sand bunkers protect a few greens making a great experience for golfers. Pinecrest was named best municipal golf course in Idaho for 2009 by Golf Digest.

But beneath its good looks, the 7,426 yard par 72 layout has real teeth, challenging your mind as well as your body as you navigate its wonderfully crafted fairways. Strategic elevation changes add to the interest on several holes. Teton Reserve is definitely a gem worth discovering – only 25 minutes from Jackson Hole.
